What happens when we get the staff trained? We then open the doors for the first two residents and immediately start working with them. The State Department of Health sends their Surveyors to inspect our operation in the certification phase. When the Department of Health certifies SON Valley, then we go ahead and bring in the rest of the 20 residents. So, if you are interested in getting your loved one into Phase 1, please contact us as soon as possible. The two homes are filling up fast. I am pleased to announce the addition of Danny Berry as our new Director of Development. Danny is perfect for the job and we are very fortunate to get him. He will also remain as Pastor at Center Terrace Baptist in Canton. Welcome aboard, Brother Danny!
